# Be on the ball Early registration for 2018

#### Registrations opened on November 1 and we have about players 100 registered to date.

It may seem as though the 2017 season is barely over, but there is a lot of planning in progress for next season and it is very important that the club has an early indication of player numbers for 2018 so that we can plan teams and coaching staff well in advance of the season start.

We strongly encourage all players wishing to return in 2018 to sign up as soon as possible as there may be limited spots in some age groups next season; so it will be first in, best dressed.

#### Auskick v Junior Registrations

Auskickers register via a different link to juniors and it is very important to ensure that the correct link is used.

IMPORTANT: If your child is moving from Auskick to U9s (Juniors) in 2018, please make sure you register them as a Junior. Additionally, you will need to perform the registration as a NEW Player (not a returning player).

If your child is 8 years old but they want to play in the U9 junior competition (i.e. NOT Auskick) then please drop an email to manlybombersrego@gmail.com letting us know of your intent – as U8s are generally eligible for Auskick.

#### **Active Kids Voucher**

The NSW Government has announced a new 'Active Kids Voucher' program. This program aims to provide each school aged child (Kindergarten – Year 12) access to a voucher to the value of \$100 to be used to subsidise sporting club registrations. Manly Bombers will be a registered provider under the scheme so you may choose to redeem your voucher against the cost of registration. You can also use it for other registered providers or sports teams

Because this is a new scheme, some of the final details are yet to be announced. We have been advised that the vouchers will become available to parents on January 31, but if we have received any payments for registration before that date, the voucher will not be able to be used against registration costs. It is very important therefore that the following is understood:

If you want to redeem your \$100 voucher against the cost of registration with Manly Bombers, please register your child as soon as possible via the Bombers' website but DO NOT PAY ANYTHING AT THIS STAGE. (i.e. selection of the REGO FEE PAYMENT option on the payment screen is OPTIONAL if you intend to use your voucher for rebate against Manly Bombers rego fees).

If you will be redeeming your \$100 voucher somewhere else, please register your child as soon as possible via the Bombers' website and pay the registration fee in full by selecting the \$190 payment option when presented.
